Prof María del Valle Juárez (Argentina)

Dr. María del Valle Juárez is a pediatrician and epidemiologist based in Buenos Aires, Argentina.

She holds a Master's degree in Public Health from the University of Buenos Aires and has extensive experience in vaccine-preventable diseases and respiratory virus epidemiology.

She worked for more than a decade with the Argentine Ministry of Health in the National Directorate for the Control of Vaccine-Preventable Diseases (DICEI), and contributed to vaccine impact studies and national immunization strategies.

She currently works at Hospital de Niños Ricardo Gutiérrez, where she coordinates multicenter surveillance studies on respiratory viruses.
