Obituary – Dilip Sen

Dilip was born on the 4th of May 1934 in Singapore where his father was Professor of Bacteriology. His schooling was in Singapore and India. He passed his MBBS with Honors from the University of Calcutta in 1958 and proceeded to the UK in 1960 after his basic training. He obtained his MRCOG in 1962, followed by FRCS Edin and then his PhD in 1969 from the University of Manchester where he worked at St.Mary's Hospital in the department of Pathology. He joined the University of Malaya in 1969 and later became Associate Professor and Head of the department. In 1984 he moved to the National University of Singapore and also took the responsibility of Editor of the Singapore Journal of Obstetrics & Gynaecology. Dilip had a brilliant academic and clinical career and was a great teacher, who taught and trained many obstetricians and gynaecologists around the world. In 1993 he retired following a minor stroke and moved to Germany with his wife. He passed away peacefully on the 27'th November 2004. He leaves behind his wife Joya, daughter Kamala and son Ramen. He will be fondly remembered by many of his students for his sense of humor and dedicated clinical and academic contributions.
