## WELCOME MESSAGE



Dear Colleagues and Friends,

On behalf of the Organising Committee, I welcome all of you to the Singapore Diabetes in Pregnancy Conference (SDIP) & Integrated Platform for Research in Advancing Metabolic Health Outcomes of Women and Children (IPRAMHO) Asia Meeting 2018 at KK Women's and Children's Hospital, Singapore.

Diabetes, obesity and gestational diabetes mellitus (GDM) is a worldwide problem. Asian ethnicities are particularly prone to diabetes and gestational diabetes with high prevalences. This is an issue which many countries in Asia are rightly focusing on now. At Day 2, the programme will invite the AOFOG MFM committee and regional experts in GDM to

discuss screening and diagnostic approaches for GDM as well as future research to address the current gaps in GDM in Asia-Oceania. Here we have support from various hospitals in countries of Asia-Oceania including Australia, China, Indonesia, Japan, Myanmar, Malaysia, Philippines, Sri Lanka & Thailand. There will be a consensus workshop on GDM in Asia-Oceania and also a research investigator network meeting to initiate the first joint multicentre study in GDM in Asia-Oceania.

I am happy for the support by several key organizations - College of Obstetricians & Gynaecologists, Singapore (COGS), Obstetrical & Gynaecological Society of Singapore (OGSS), Perinatal Society of Singapore (PSS), Maternal Fetal Medicine (MFM) Committee of the Asia and Oceania Federation of Obstetrics & Gynaecology (AOFOG) and SingHealth Duke-NUS OBGYN Academic Clinical Programme and SingHealth Duke-NUS Diabetes Centre.
